Direct Debit Guarantee

This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.

If you request The Hawks' Charitable Trust (The Trust) to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.

If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, The Trust will notify you ten working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed.

If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by The Trust or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.

If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when The Trust asks you to.

You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

Increase the value of your donation with Gift Aid

If you are a UK taxpayer, you can declare that all donations made under your declaration should be treated as Gift Aid donations. Doing so maximises your gift: currently we can reclaim 25p for every £1 you donate at no further cost to you. You must have paid an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) that you donate to will reclaim on your gifts for that tax year. NB: Other taxes that you may pay, such as VAT or Council Tax, do not qualify for Gift Aid relief. Please consider a Gift Aid donation wherever possible.

Your declaration covers donations that you may make in the future. Please notify the Hawk's Club Administrator if you change your name or address while the declaration remains in force, or cease to be a UK tax-payer. You may cancel the declaration by notifying the Administrator. The declaration will not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellation or specified later date.
