You must use this form to make an application for funds from the Hawks' Charitable Trust.

Please complete as many entries as you can, since all the information will be taken into consideration when determining awards.

In particular please note the section requiring support from your Tutor. Without this your application will not be considered.

The list of award recipients is published on the Hawks' website. Please confirm on the form that you are happy to be included on that list.

Please ensure that your email address is legible – all communication with applicants will be by email.

You may append to this form a single sheet, limited to 400 words, describing in your own words why you believe you are suitable for an award from the Trust. This is not essential.

The awards are for the support of achieving sporting excellence in the current academic year, which should be taken to mean a minimum of representing Cambridge University at first team level in a recognised sport.

A recognised sport is normally taken to be one awarded a Blue or Half Blue. However this is not a barrier if your sport is not, provided your level of excellence is very high.

Sporting excellence at national or international level is taken into account, as is the level that the sport achieves at BUCS or similar.

Awards are open equally to men and women.

The Trustees recognise the strictures of modern student funding (maintenance loans, bursaries etc) as being the 'norm'. Particularly difficult financial situations that might otherwise restrict the attainment of sporting excellence are noteworthy, as are unusual costs incurred for training and competition.

Applications must be received by 13th February 2018.
