## Internationals and Olympians List

In 2017 we prepared and issued further lists of Olympians and Full Internationals for each of the clubs who were able to contribute.

In this latest 150th Anniversary edition we have updated existing lists and added fresh names of élite athletes. These come from a much broader range of clubs and, indeed, nations too. Ten new clubs are featured and our nine Tokyo 2020 (2021) Olympians – including a Gold medallist – are acknowledged as well. Further, we are pleased to have added many women athletes who had not previously been celebrated.

Last time we celebrated almost 890 different athletes who have represented their country at senior level: this time the number stands at 983, including 8 Olympic medals previously unrecorded.

We have also re-presented separately the records of the Olympics from 1896: 356 athletes from 18 countries are now celebrated. These men and women have won more than 200 medals.

It is worth noting that, in an era where academic pressures are ever higher, the stream of performance athletes across a broadening platform of sports remains strong.

The Hawks' and The Ospreys Clubs salute all who are listed here. We expect to issue further editions in the future both of new and not-so-new champions.
